Requirements

- 1. Applicants can present proposals according to the congress title or working tables.
- 2. Proposals must be submitted on time by the following date: Since the call is presented up to September 28,2020. Where applicants must specify the name of the talk, summary, author (s) affiliation institution and an email.
- 3. Paper proposals (maximum half page) will be ruled by the Organizing Committee
- 4. Same authors cannot participate in more than 2 (two) talks/presentations
- 5. Maximum 3 authors per talk
- 6. Admitted or rejected applications are going to be revealed in October 10th, 2020
- 7. Admitted proposals must provide the full text as an article before November 8th .2020
- 8. Each work must be handed with printed and electronic versions, on letter size paper, in Word format, Times New Roman 12, 1.5 line spacing.
- 9. The best presented works would be considered for publication through a double-blind arbitration. Works are going to be examine by the internal editorial committee. Those papers accepted for publication will have written notification as soon as the process is over.
- 10. Maximum extension of 20 pages (including notes, graphic information, and bibliography).
- 11. Bibliographic references in the text must be in Harvard referencing style: (Zamora y Navarro, 2015: 2015).
- 12. At the end of the text consulted sources must be presented, we suggest following the next format:
 - Zamora Torres, América I. y Navarro Chávez, José César Lenin. 2015. Competitividad de la administración de las aduanas en el marco del comercio internacional, *Contaduría y Administración*, 60(1), 2015-228.
- 13. Tables and graphs must show measurement units, base year and whether it is percentual variation or absolute terms and the item. Those would be attached separately from the text (and the place where they should be putted will be indicated there. In the same way, the name of the corresponding file will be shown. For numbering it must be used Arabic system (Table 1,2,3, etc.) and the direct source must be signaled). Furthermore, they must be presented in black and white.
